In the eight years that Temporary Residence has been releasing music, we have never done a proper label compilation or budget-priced sampler of any kind. The closest we've ever gotten to any such thing was the *Sounds of the Geographically Challenged* CD, which simply acted as a convenient means for gathering the out-of-print split 12" EPs all onto one disc. Even then we wrestled with the decision to release it as a compilation for one simple reason: compilations are shitty. We can probably count the number of solid, essential compilations released in the last 20 years on one hand, with fingers to spare. Why then, would we go and jeopardize a good thing by releasing an inexpensive label compilation? Because this one's not shitty. As a matter of fact, it's pretty damned amazing.

When our 50th release (and subsequently our 8th year in business) was approaching, we wanted to do something special, so we approached the most special people we knew, namely our bands and our friends. Each band answered with a brand new, exclusive song for the compilation, most of which were recorded specifically with this release in mind. Every song is stunning and there truly is not a weak link in the whole set. It is 65 minutes of heart-stopping beauty and drama, the way we like to bring it to you.

For the artwork, we turned to our friends and fans. We held a contest of sorts, offering everyone the chance to submit their work for possible inclusion in the extensive 24-page full-color booklet. We weren't quite prepared for the abundance of totally brilliant work, and – coupled with the beautiful drawings and paintings that some of our friends sent us (including professional skateboarding legend Ed Templeton, Rumah Sakit artist Jeremiah Maddock and NYC/LA artist Ashley Snow) – we found ourselves at a total stand-still for months on end while we picked through all the artwork. The end result is a package that rests as the single proudest display this label has ever released. For a format that is so notoriously disappointing, we sure lucked out on this one. But get it while you can, before we remember that compilations are supposed to be shitty.
